BLACK HISTORY THROUGH THE EYES OF HIP HOP

Black History 365 (BH365) and Minneapolis Public Schools (MPS) teamed up to present the Black History through Eyes of Hip Hop launch party event on Tuesday, June 4, 2024.

Students throughout the district are now engaging with materials that provide the full range of Black history from ancient Africa through modern times and are learning the rich stories and achievements of people of African Americans. To mark this milestone, BH365 hosted an artistic showcase of student performances featuring dance, spoken word, and musical performances to pay homage to the rich legacy of Black Americans and commemorate the 50th anniversary of hip hop. More than 1,000 students from 20 schools across the district attended the event held at Northrup Theater on the campus of the University of Minnesota.
